Explanation for Non-Achievement of Recovery Targets under NMDFC & YSLS

Whereas, Worthy Director JKEDI took a review meeting on 10th Dec, 2024 at 02.00 PM from his office chamber at JKEDI Office Bari Brahmna.

Whereas, while taking the review of the Recovery under YSLS/NMDFC (October/November, 2024) performance of your district as retrieved from available data in achieving recovery targets is not satisfactory and failure to meet the designated targets is a matter of serious concern for the institute.

Whereas, failure to achieve the recovery targets not only reflects poorly on your District performance but also negatively impacts the overall objectives, reputation of the institute & the Quarterly repayments to be made to NMDFC.

In light of the above, you alongwith with your team comprising of Shri Imtiyaz Ahad Malla (Associate Project Manager) & Shri Vishal Sharma (Office Associate) are hereby directed to submit a written justification within 2 days of receiving this notice, detailing the reasons for failure to achieve the assigned recovery targets and why not proceed with below mentioned punishments against you & each member of your team:

- Inter-Division transfer.
- Withholding Salary.
- 3. Censure with red entry in service book.

Further, if your reply is not received within the stipulated time period, it shall be construed that you have nothing to say in this regard & above mentioned punishments shall be initiated against you & your team without any further notice in this regard.
